

NASAL/SINUS SURGERY

POST OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

WHAT TO EXPECT

- mild/moderate pain and swelling.
- nasal bleeding
- nasal obstruction
- low grade fever
- upper teeth numbness (temporary)
- any material or suture placed in the nose is absorbable. Packing, gauze, or sponges are not used unless specifically directed by your surgeon.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Afrin nasal spray may be used to help control excessive nasal bleeding spray in directly
 or saturate a cotton ball and place into the nostril. Do not use Afrin for more than a few
 days!
- You may gently blow your nose 7 days after surgery.
- Begin using saline nasal 1 day after surgery as often as possible, at least 4 times per day.
 We recommend the NeilMed Sinus Rinse Kit available in our office or at most pharmacies.

MEDICATION

Use prescription pain medication or Acetaminophen as necessary.

ACTIVITY

Avoid strenuous activity for one week.

DIET

No restrictions.

POST OP APPOINTMENT

Usually 1 week after surgery.

WHEN TO CALL

- Call the office during routine hours for questions, concerns, changes, or refills of any medication. Make sure there is enough pain medication to avoid after-hour calls.
- After hours calls should be limited to urgent problems such as excessive bleeding, pain, vision change or fever over 102 that does not respond to fluids and Acetaminophen.
